**Question:** I would like to know if you offer Semi-Private lessons and if you do, what are your prices. Also what is your instructor to patron ratio as well. Thank you for your help.

### Answers:

City & County of Broomfield- we do offer private lessons - they are \$20/half hour for a private, \$30 for a semi private (In instructor to 2 kids). Our fees have been the same forever!!!!

Englewood- Our prices are per person for Semi privates. \$14 per person/lesson or they can buy a package to save \$ 4 semi privates for \$50/per person. Because it is a per person fee we allow more than 2 people to participate if they choose.

**Question/Topic:** On December 4, 2008 at 1:00pm there will be a meeting held by the Department of Labor and Employment. A letter was sent out from the Department of Labor and Employment. It is in regards to a bill that was passed which requires amusement parks (including any entity with a water slide/attraction?) to be regulated by the State of Colorado. The following requirements that we are concerned about are as follows:

1. 1 million dollar insurance policy per attraction
2. Slides must be inspected annually while fully operating. Inspection will take place in April. It will require a certificate of inspection - State of Colorado.
3. Cost will be \$125 annually for each attraction (what is considered an attraction? Slides, play features, bubblers, splash pads, etc.)
4. No clear definition of what a slide is (mechanized rides, certain height of slide tower, play structure slides??)

We (City of Westminster and Hyland Hills) will be attending the meeting and I would like to get a count on how many entities this would affect. Please send me an email stating how many slides/attractions your organization has and how this many affect your operations. If you have any other questions, please feel free to send me an email.

**Question/Topic:** Who has concrete decks in their pool areas? If you do, please let me know if you have had any problems (slippery, cracking, algae, mold, etc...). If you have had problems what steps did you take to address them?

### Responses:

City of Fort Collins- We have an indoor pool w/concrete and also an outdoor pool. Definite cracking issues at the outdoor pool and fading of our colored concrete. Indoor pool issues: Minor cracks, Slippery in the more sloped areas(cover w/ Dri-Dek matting) We also had it sealed last year and you can control the amount of rubber grit that is added which makes a huge difference. Some minor algae issues in the caulk lines that don't drain properly(use Santi-T10 Deck disinfectant 2X/week).
